## What is Christian Recovery Houses?

Christian Recovery Houses, Inc. is a not-for-profit Christ-centered residential halfway house ministry in Wilmington, NC that shares in the recovery of residents by leading, teaching and embracing every resident in their new Christ filled walk.

## How are we different?

The difference between CRH and other halfway houses is the belief that true recovery and the joy that accompanies it can only be realized through Jesus Christ. Residents spend time in Bible study, prayer and worship on a daily basis, and will attend Christ-centered 12-step meetings and services as a part of their weekly affairs. We believe sobriety will always be lacking when practiced outside a fruitful and abounding relationship with God the Father, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit.

## Frequently Asked Questions:

### **Does CRH serve men and women?**

Yes, 24 men's beds (3 homes) and 12 ladies' beds (1 home), and a pregnancy in recovery focused home in development.

### **How much does it cost to enter the program?**

Weekly program fees are \$130. There is a one time application fee of \$170 with \$100 of that fee being refunded upon graduation.

### **What is the admission process?**

First, we conduct a phone interview and assessment to make sure our program is a good fit for you. If approved, then an application and handbook of rules is reviewed and signed.

### **Can family members visit me?**

Of course. Sundays are the best day for visits.

### **Where do residents attend church?**

Port City Community Church/ PC3 in Wilmington, NC

### **How long has CRH been operating?**

CRH has been operating for over a decade. Most of our volunteers and board members have been with us since the beginning.

### **How long do people stay with CRH?**

We recommend spending 6 months to a year to achieve a higher probability of reentering community and remaining clean, sober and productive. Those individuals who remain in our houses for 6 months or longer have a significantly higher success rate than those who leave after a shorter period. It simply takes time to heal, form new Godly habits and change an entire method of living.
